

Karachi Port operations  
KARACHI : Four ships carrying ethanol, crude oil and containers are expected to arrive at the outer anchorage of Karachi Port on Saturday, said a KPT source.

Oriental Protea, Taipei, Helios Triumph, Violetta and Hammonia Galciam were berthed on Friday. While Cape, Kota Karim, AL Jalaa and Helios Triumph sailed out. Violetta, Nordic Tianjin, Jacksonville, Taipei, Tug Jacksonville, Du Juan Song and Hammonia Gallicum were due to depart.

A cargo volume of 96,594 tonnes comprising 83,415 tonnes of import and 13,179 tonnes of export was handled. Following ships are due to arrive on Saturday: DI Ace with ethanol, AL Yarmouk with crude oil, Oocl Britain and APL Brisbane with containers.

Port Qasim

KARACHI: Two ships carrying containers and diesel oil arrived at the outer anchorage during the last 24 hours, said a PQA release.

Meanwhile five ships carrying edible oil, furnace oil and cement also arrived at outer anchorage. Four ships Hamminia Pacificum, Al- Soor-II, Out Rivaling and Argent Cosmos were busy in loading and offloading containers, diesel oil, iron ore and edible oil. A cargo volume of 76645 tonnes comprising 60916 tonnes of import and 15729 tonnes of export was handled.
