National Electric Power Regulation Authority (Nepa) has approved price hike of Rs 1.55 per unit in electricity tariff. The latest price hike in electricity tariff would be adjusted in the month of January in term of fuel adjustment.
It was told during the hearing that furnace oil of Rs 63 billion were purchased in the month of January. In the month of January per unit fuel charges remained Rs 10.55.
