**ISLAMABAD:** High Commissioner of the Maldives Aishath Shehenaz Adam has urged the Pakistani business community to explore untapped trade prospects by holding single country exhibitions in the Maldives. {loadposition content\_adsense300}She was talking to a delegation of the Islamabad Chamber of Commerce and Industry (ICCI), according to a press statement issued on Monday.
